Classroom Information

Tutoring

Students are strongly urged to attend tutoring classes if their performance is falling below passing in a subject area and have academic need. The weekly sessions may take place immediately before or after school. STAAR tutoring is offered in the fall and spring. Tutoring days will be set by the teacher.

Conferences

Communication between parents and teachers is an important phase of the individualized instruction program. The progress of your child can be discussed at a scheduled conference time.

The teachers are available during their planning period throughout the school year to discuss with parents any phase of the student's progress. Before and after school times can be arranged as well. A convenient time can be arranged by calling school office or by sending an email to the teacher.

Progress Reports

Progress reports will be given to all students at the end of the third week in each nine-week quarter, except for the 1st quarter when progress reports will only be sent to students who are failing at the time.

These notices are to be signed by the parent and returned to the teacher. You can also sign up to have electronic access to your child's grades at any time through Focus.

School Communication

Every Tuesday, a folder is sent home with each student that contains school information. This school information includes: student work, school announcements, holiday dates, school events, and PTA flyers.

This folder will contain other information from your child's teacher. Please take a few minutes to go through the envelope with your child and sign the cover, if required, and return the folder to school the next day.

Our school website and all calls will be the school's primary source of communication. Each teacher also has a class phone, an email address, and uses Class Dojo as their modes of communication.

Parents are encouraged to check our website frequently for information. A phone call, text message, and/or an email will be used to keep parents informed of upcoming events. These brief, calls typically go out around 7 pm.
