Children who don't read during the summer can lose up to two months of learning by the time they return to school in the fall.









Light Blue	Reread one of your favorite books.
	Read in your pajamas.
	Read in a pillow fort.
Pink	Read outside underneath a tree.
	Read a book by your favorite author.
	Try a new game - read the directions for the game and play with someone.
Orange	Tell an adult three facts you read in a book.
	Read with a flashlight.
Red	Read for 30 minutes straight.
	Read out loud to a little kid.
	Read in bed.
Yellow	Read to your favorite stuff animal.
	Read to a relative over the phone or computer.
	Read to your family pet.
Green	Visit the public library and get a new book - read the book.
	Read a biography. Go to the library resources to learn more interesting facts about that person!
	Read a play out loud with a group of friends. (try funny voices, mannerisms, etc)
Blue	Read a magazine article OR go on eNewsela, create a free account and choose an article to read. There are so many neat choices with all kinds of topics!
	Create a word journal throughout the summer of words that are interesting, make you curious, you don't know the meaning, etc. Make this journal throughout the summer with a growing list of words.


