As we continue to work through the planning process for our school expansion project to add additional classrooms and common area spaces, we're committed to keeping you updated on the progress.

Construction work is now underway and the temporary modified traffic pattern is in effect for streets surrounding the school during drop off and dismissal times. Our staff and students are doing a great job of continuing teaching and learning while construction efforts occur safely in segregated areas of the campus. The construction manager has a strong awareness of our school schedules and every effort is being made to plan the construction work around school operations.

The next step in the process with the City of Dallas is a public meeting related to the Fill Permit that RISD has requested in order to be able to begin the flood plain mitigation work. This City meeting will take place at the school on January 24 at 6:30 p.m. in the cafeteria. Any parents, residents, staff members or stakeholders interested in learning more about the plans to mitigate the flood plain on our campus is encouraged to attend.
